INTRODUCTION TO THE WEEK

Within our SCITT partnership our partner schools have diverse and varied areas of expertise. We believe that the true sense of partnership involves our partners sharing their best practice to our trainees. To this end we have launched our carousel week, which will run from Monday 15th January 2018 to Thursday 18th January 2018. You will receive training in the following schools:

Elmwood School: This experience will focus on effective provision and adaptations to teaching for students with Special Education Needs and Disabilities (SEND). The experience will be supplemented by a session during the Whole Cohort Day 5.

Grace Academy Darlaston: The focus of this experience is effective provision and adaptations to teaching for students for whom English is an Additional Language (EAL).

Barr Beacon School: The focus of this experience is the observation of Most Able provision and teaching through guided observation. This will be supplemented by a group discussion at the end of the day.

Bloxwich Academy: This experience will focus on workshops, observations and teaching experiences of effective provision in a school where Pupil Premium pupils are the majority.

Welcome to Elmwood School. We are an 11-16 Social, Emotional and Mental Health community special school. We have 64 pupils on roll and of that we have 5 pupils in Key Stage 4 who access an alternative provision due to us not meeting their need or for a specific curriculum domain we are unable to offer (due to size of the school). Pupils are usually taught in groups of 6 with up to 2 teaching assistants to support the learning and social and emotional development. Department Time

During the time in the department they will be shown around by L O'Brien (DoL), where the advantages of being a through school will be explained. Trainees will be given some time to prepare their sessions in small groups – any resources they need for their can be provided (eg; MWBs, pens, dice, ect).

Year 10 Lesson

Trainees can choose to team teach or deliver the lesson on their own. There will be a selection of topics (see below), and trainees can choose to deliver the topic on their own for 15-20 minutes or have the opportunity to team teach the lesson if they prefer.

The lessons that have been chosen for you to observe show our top set in year 7 (where a number of pupils achieve 120 in their KS2 SATs) and the year 12 maths group. Both these groups will demonstrate the high standards, outstanding teaching and expectations that we have in the department, as well as demonstrating the love of learning that the teachers in the Mathematics department are creating so pupils who achieved a grade 9 in their GCSE are choosing to remain at Bloxwich Academy to complete their A-Levels. You will complete a 15/20 minute observation of the two groups, then there will some time for you to come together and reflect on the lessons you have observed.
