Review previous steps:
 Those identified as G, T & MA didn't maintain the accelerated progress from the Spring Term 2019. Greater development is still required regarding the curriculum enhancement across all 3 terms to enable a consistent flow of opportunities.
 (2/12) 17% of teh KS3 NFSM writing group have maintained level of progress from SPT to SUT 2019.
 (3/5) 60% of the KS4 NFSM English group have maintained level of progress from SPT to SUT 2019, 67% of this cohort were Year 11 leavers so were on examination leave and had left school end of June 2019.
 (1/5) 20% of teh KS4 NFSM Maths group have maintained the same level of progress from SPT to SUT 2019. This was a year 11 leaver as well.
 0% of the KS3 NFSM Maths group could be classified as coasting.
 LCh achieved his Level 2 / 46APS in English and Maths.
