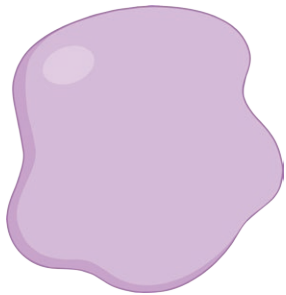


Bacterial Resistance Storyboard

Rearrange the sentences into the correct order to show how bacterial resistance develops. Draw a picture too, to illustrate each stage.

1. An injury is sustained.
2. Antibiotics are prescribed.
3. The resistant bacteria start to multiply and remain in the person's system.
4. The wound has become infected.
5. If the antibiotics are prescribed again, they will have no effect and an alternative has to be found.
6. The course of antibiotics has been completed and yet bacteria remain.
7. The infected wound contains both susceptible and resistant bacteria.
8. The antibiotics destroy the susceptible bacteria and the resistant bacteria remain.
