



Food Bank Services

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- Emergency food package consisting of £10 worth of essential items such as bread, eggs, milk, tinned foods, cereals and biscuits (dietary needs taken into consideration before parcels are produced)
 - Initially we were getting an average of 8 referrals
 - This has increased more than 100% to 18-22 packs being distributed weekly
- Some of these packs have been a repeated request due to ongoing financial difficulties of the service user.
 - No vouchers are required just an email or phone call referral
- We also are able to offer food bank services in line with cultural and religious needs as we cater for a diverse community.



Homeless/Hygiene Packs

Homeless Packs

- Winter warm pack including hat: scarves, socks, gloves and a thermal blanket.
 - First we were receiving 1-2 requests which has increased to an average of 26
- Dry food packs including: water, crisps, breakfast bars.
 - Male and female hygiene packs
- Consisting of essentials such as toothpaste/brush, tissues, hand/body wash, sanitary products, razors etc.
- Initially we had anticipated that this service would be more important to the homeless community however we have had requests from social workers to provide packs to those on low incomes and zero hour incomes.
