## THEATRE VISIT ON 29.3.22

As part of the social reading curriculum, and BTEC Performing Arts course, we are organising a trip to see the stage adaptation of 'The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time' at the Birmingham Hippodrome theatre on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.

Students will remain in school at the end of the school day and will then be transported by school minibus to the theatre and returned to school after the show. Food will be provided prior to departing for the theatre. Parents/carers are responsible for collecting children upon their return to school. The show starts at 7:30 pm and finishes approximately 9:50-10pm and our estimated time of arrival back at school will be approximately 10.30pm.

If your child usually takes any medication between these times, that medication will be required in school the day before the trip so that we can ensure that medication continues to be administered at the correct times.

This trip is aimed at students who have read the text this academic year or are interested in studying performing arts. Tickets are £24 each and, to help towards costs, a voluntary contribution would be very much appreciated.

Students are welcome to bring some money (no more than £10), in case they wish to purchase any souvenirs/treats at the Theatre.

Due to the late return to school, the children would not be expected into school until 11 am on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> March. As such, they would need to make their own way to school if they are usually on Local Authority transport however, should they wish to come in as normal, then they are more than welcome to do so.
