



## EDUCATION SESSIONS FOR SCHOOLS, COLLEGES AND ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PROVISIONS

### **Logistics**

### **Primary schools**

**Reception** 20mins-

- What do we do online?

**Year 1-2** 30mins-

- Having those safe conversations with our children around online devices.

**Year 3-4** 40mins-

- Online Safety -

*Discussing and having interactive discussions with our children about both social media influences and keeping safe.*





Year 5-6 45mins-

- Online/Offline-

*Discussing and having interactive discussions with our children about both social media influences and keeping safe online and in the community.*

### Secondary schools

Assembly 30-45mins-

- What is grooming?
- The push/pull factors for our young people...
- How can you protect your friend?

We ask schools after the assembly to follow up with both the below sessions for all year groups **Year 7-13:**

**Child Sexual Exploitation presentation 1 hour –**

- Discussing the types of exploitation.
- The signs of exploitation.
- What does a victim and perpetrator look like for them?

**Criminal Exploitation presentation 1hour-**

- Discussing real issues young people are facing in terms of exploitation.
- What is a Criminal?
- The influences/pressures both social media and environment can have on our young people.

The below session is for year groups **Year 10-13:**

**Exposure- Dangers of Pornography 1hour-**

- Discussing what is pornography and how it affects relationships.
- How it impacts views around sex and how it rewires your brain.
- Addiction- The new drug.

The secondary school presentations can also be delivered in Colleges and other education providers.
